I'm sure you'll notice a BIG difference at home.





What's Happening In September

This month we begin reading and writing silly stories in Language Arts. During this unit your child will build good reading habits by monitoring their reading, by being able to summarize BIG events. As well they will be working on writing their own stories with Brilliant Beginnings, Marvelous Middles, and Excellent Endings.

In Math we have begun exploring place value up to the 100s place. A deep understanding of this will assist your child in adding and subtraction, which we begin later this week. In addition we are working with students on how to read and solve word problems.

In Science, your child will become a **sense**sational scientist as we explore the five senses. Each week your child will use the scientific process to discover the ways each sense works. Please use the science links with your child to help fuel their curiosity in this topic. So far, the kids are having a blast!
